**OBJECTION TO PROPOSED REVISION TO WAITING RESTRICTIONS – OLD GARDENS, WINCHESTER**

Your recent letter objecting to the proposed extension and introduction of waiting restrictions in Old Gardens, Winchester has been forwarded to me for reply as it is this section that will be taking this matter forward for decision.

It is not possible to extend the extent of the restrictions now that they have been advertised as this would be a material change to the proposal and any such changes would require a new proposal to be consulted on and advertised, etc.

I do not believe that the proposed revisions will have any significant effect on the parking patterns immediately adjacent to 13 Park Road and, if anything, will make emergency access to Old Gardens better.

Due to the volume of objections now received this matter will need to go to Committee for decision. Your objection will be included in the Report accordingly. Although I intend to recommend that the proposal be implemented as advertised it is possible that due to the number of objections the proposal may be withdrawn completely.

I will contact you with details of the meeting as soon as it has been arranged so that you may attend to make a personal representation if you so wish. In the meantime I would ask that you reconsider your objection.
