## ONE WAY TRAFFIC FLOWS, PARCHMENT STREET and MIDDLE BROOK STREET, WINCHESTER

TAKE NOTICE that on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2004 Winchester City Council on behalf of Hampshire County Council made an experimental traffic regulation order as follows:-

## EFFECT OF ORDER:

- 1. To reverse the flow of traffic in Parchment Street, Winchester from a southerly direction to a northerly direction.
- 2. To revoke the one-way traffic order in Middle Brook Street from its junction with North Walls to its junction with Cossack Lane. (Traffic on Middle Brook Street to remain one-way only southbound from its junction with Cossack Lane to its junction with Friarsgate.)
- 3. To introduce a "No Entry" restriction from Middle Brook Street into North Walls.
- 4. To introduce a "No Right Turn" restriction from North Walls into Middle Brook Street.

## **IMPLEMENTATION**

The Order will come into effect on 8th November 2004.

The Order is to be on an experimental basis for a maximum period of 18 months and the Council will, in due course consider whether the provisions of the Order should continue in force indefinitely.

<u>OBJECTIONS:</u> Within a period of six months from when the experimental Order comes into force or, if the Order is subsequently varied or modified within six months of the date of the coming into force of such variation or modification any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation.

All objections must be in writing, stating the grounds on which they are made and sent to the undersigned.
