WAITING RESTRICTION PROPOSALS LYNFORD AVENUE AND LYNFORD WAY, WINCHESTER

Further to the extension of the waiting restrictions in Lynford Avenue and Lynford Way that was introduced in July 2004 it has been brought to the Council's attention that there are still significant problems with access for larger vehicles caused by inconsiderate parking in Lynford Avenue and Lynford Way.

It is therefore proposed to introduce further restrictions to be placed on one side of Lynford Avenue and Lynford Way so that parking is controlled, as shown on the plan overleaf. The introduction of this proposal, as with previous proposals, is subject to objections, and it cannot be guaranteed that it will be implemeted.

The proposed extended waiting restrictions are in accordance with the existing Controlled Parking Zone restrictions throughout Winchester, 'No waiting 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday' and as such will only require the introduction of a single yellow line and no other additional signage.

The proposal is being formally advertised from Friday 23rd September 2005. Notices will be in the Hampshire Chronicle and on street accordingly. Additional information can be viewed at the City Council Offices in Colebrook Street.
