New Article:-

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO INCREASE FEES FOR RESIDENTS PARKING PERMITS
AND TO INTRODUCE A REDUCTION IN FEES FOR ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY
VEHICLES

Winchester City Council on behalf of Hampshire County Council proposes making a traffic regulation order as follows :-

EFFECT OF ORDER:

1. To increase the fees for Residents and or Visitors Parking Permits in both Inner and Outer Areas (First Permit) from £20.00 per annum to £24.00 per annum.
2. To introduce a discount in the fees for Residents Parking Permits for “environmentally friendly vehicles” for :-
 - a) the first permit issued in the Inner Area (Article 18 of the Principal Order)
 - b) the first and second permits issued in the Outer Area (Article 19 of the Principal Order) for

VED Band A - 75% discount
VED Band B - 50% discount

FURTHER DETAILS : a copy of this notice, the proposed order, a map showing the location and effect of the proposal, a statement of reasons and the order to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the following place:-

- (i) City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

OBJECTIONS: All objections and other representations in respect of this proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 21st July 2006.
All objections must state the grounds on which they are made.

Variation of Fees for On-Street Parking Permits in Winchester

Winchester City Council is proposing to revise the fees for on-street parking permits as described below. This increase is necessary to make the residents' parking permit scheme as close to cost neutral as possible.

It is proposed to increase the fee for the first permit from £20.00 to £24.00 per annum.

Please note that the fees for all subsequent permits are to remain unchanged.

In accordance with the Council's policy to protect and enhance the environment and improve the air quality in Winchester it is also proposed to offer discounts to "environmentally friendly vehicles" registered as either VED Band A or B as follows.

VED Band A - 75% discount

VED Band B – 50% discount

For the proposed variations to come into effect a variation to the existing order must be made as shown overleaf.
