EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The attached timetable for 2011/12 is broadly the same as the timetable agreed for previous Municipal Years.

In compiling the timetable, the following assumptions have been made:-

- (a) Cabinet will continue to meet monthly for most of the year and in the morning (9.30am).
- (b) Planning Development Control (PDC) Committee will continue to meet on one full day (usually a Thursday) every three weeks, commencing at 9.30am.
- (c) the four Scrutiny Panels will meet four times per year, enabling more timely quarterly reporting targets (other than in the July cycle of meetings where there is a tight deadline in supplying outturn information for the July meetings) and also offering more scope for the timing of Informal Scrutiny Groups. It is not possible for the July meetings to be moved any later without the meetings being held during the school summer holidays.
- (d) four meetings of the Licensing & Regulation, Personnel and Standards Committees have been scheduled (the Licensing & Regulation Sub-Committee and Standards Sub-Committee will continue to meet on an ad-hoc basis when required).
- (e) The provisional date for the September Council meeting has been retained following its reintroduction in 2010.

In addition to a number of requests and comments which Members have made regarding the planning of the next timetable, there are also statutory and budgetary considerations, as well as pre-existing Guildhall bookings, all of which constrain the 'perfect' timing of meetings. However, the attached timetable has achieved the following:-

- (f) full Council meetings have been scheduled to avoid County Council school holidays and political party conferences.
- (g) the budget setting Council in February is scheduled to tie in with the timescale dictated by when the County Council agrees its precept, in addition to the joint deadline set by all Hampshire districts to produce the composite Council Tax leaflet used by all authorities.
- (h) as agreed for the past two years, the full Council meeting scheduled in previous years for June is no longer required, as the Government has removed the requirement for Council's to approve 'Best Value Performance Plans' by the end of June each year. This meeting has therefore been moved to mid-July, which enables the Cabinet and Principal Scrutiny Committee meetings scheduled to consider the Council's outturn reports to meet slightly later in June.
- (i) there are no direct clashes of meetings.
- (j) Principal Scrutiny Committee has, wherever possible, been scheduled to meet on a Monday following a Cabinet meeting.
- (k) An additional Statement of Accounts Committee has been scheduled for September 2011 (to receive the final Audited Statement of Accounts). This has been timetabled for the same day as a Principal Scrutiny Committee as both meetings will involve attendance by external auditors.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Timetable of Meetings for the 2011/12 Municipal Year, as set out in Appendix 1 to this report, be agreed.

To have efficient structures and procedures to provide political leadership to the Council and the District.

RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS:

The Guildhall refurbishment will create a smaller meeting room on the first floor, with disabled access, which will be utilised in the future for some smaller Committee meetings, rather than larger venues such as the Walton Room and King Charles Suite. This will enable these larger rooms to be used for external bookings, generating additional external cash income for the Council. It will also reduce the internal recharge from the Guildhall for member meetings.
