 Purpose of the meeting to discuss the Informal Town Forum Grants Panel involvement with the core grants process for 14/15

The current 3 year agreement will end in March 2015, and all funding agreements will be revisited for the following financial year (15/16) in line with the revised Community Strategy.

- Consider applications from Harestock, Badger Farm, outlying parishes around the city – this should be added to the Spring agenda.
- Possibly invite the Parishes at some point during this process for discussion.
- Report back to June 2013 Town Forum setting out awards under the new Town Forum Small Grants programme was positively received.
- Members confirmed that they wished to keep the Town forum Small Grants in 14/15.
- Agreed some TF small grants publicity was needed.
