The Reform of Council Housing Finance

1) Page 14, fifth unnumbered paragraph, last line insert the word 'only' before 'reluctantly', delete all wording after 'proposal' and insert 'but only if certain changes are made'.

2) Page 14, sixth unnumbered paragraph, first line delete 'is' and insert 'would be'.

3) Page 16 Q1, penultimate line of first paragraph delete 'only' and insert 'not', delete 'if' and insert 'unless'.

4) Page 16 Q2, second line insert 'too' between 'reasonable,' and 'many'.

5) Page 17 Q3, delete first five words in first line. Replace with 'The Council can only support this proposal if there are' before the word 'additional'.

6) Page 18 Q6, delete all after the word 'will' and insert 'not be supported by the City Council unless changes are made as indicated to make the scheme fairer to Winchesters' tenants.'
