EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The last review of the fares for hackney carriages took place at the Licensing and Regulation Committee held on 3 December 2008. The Committee resolved that no fare increase should take place at this time and a review be undertaken after a six month period.

The Licensing and Regulation Committee meeting on 10 June 2009 was cancelled after consultation with the taxi trade. The general consensus of taxi drivers at that time was that the hackney carriage drivers did not request an increase.

The current fares are those that were resolved at the Licensing and Regulation Committee held on 5 February 2008, which took effect from 1 March 2008.

When questioned whether the fares should be increased this year, many drivers consider they are in a difficult position. The costs of running a licensed vehicle (fuel, servicing etc) and the cost of insurance have all increased dramatically during the last few years. However, during this time, the taxi trade has decreased by a noticeable difference.

Maximum fares are set by the Council and take regard of the underlying inflation rates, changes to costs incurred by Hackney Carriage owners and the consequences to their paying passengers.

Appendix 2 sets out 4 possible proposals should it be considered appropriate that a fare increase should be implemented.

Appendix 3 shows a comparison of fares with other Councils locally and nationally.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1 That consideration be given as to whether the maximum fares for Hackney Carriages should be or should not be varied at this time.
- 2 That if it is considered that the fares should be varied, then subject to the statutory requirements for advertising and dealing with objections, fares which may be charged by Hackney Carriages in the area of Winchester City Council be varied, with effect from **1 February 2011**.

DETAIL:

1 Introduction

- 1.1 The maximum fares for Hackney Carriages in this District are set by this Council and have in the past been reviewed annually. However, due to the economic situation for the past few years, the last increase of the hackney carriage fares took effect on 1st March 2008 (LR 263 refers).
- 1.2 Members have since reviewed the fares but resolved that no fare increase take place at that time and a further review be undertaken after a six month period.
- 1.3 The Licensing and Regulation Committee meeting on 10 June 2009 was cancelled after consultation with the taxi trade. The general consensus at that time was that the hackney carriage drivers did not request an increase.
- 1.4 When considering whether there should be an increase in the fares the Council considers the underlying inflation rates, changes to costs incurred by Hackney Carriage owners and the consequences to fare paying passengers.
- 1.5 Licensed drivers were asked to provide views for or against an increase in fares in the September 2010 edition of the HC PH (Hackney Carriage and Private Hire) Bulletin (a newsletter sent to all drivers by the Licensing Section).
- 1.6 During Licensing Officer discussions with hackney drivers, there appeared to be a fairly even split amongst the trade regarding an increase.
- 1.7 Many drivers would like an increase in fares as the costs of fuel, insurance and servicing of their vehicle has increased significantly over the last few years, in turn the disposable income of drivers has decreased. However, several of these drivers are concerned that an increase in fares could "kill off" a currently declining trade.

2 Current Fares

- 2.1 The current fares, which commenced on 1 March 2008 are:-

Distance

For the first 660 yards (603 metres) or part thereof (minimum charge) £2.40.

For each succeeding 180 yards (165 metres) or part thereof 20p.

Waiting Time

For each period of 1 minute 25p.

Extra Charges

For each charge which commences between 11pm and 6am or at any time on Bank and Public Holidays, or after 6.30pm on Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve, or at any time on 26 December from 6am, or at any time on 1 January from 6am, an additional 50% is added to the above rate of fare.

For each hiring on Christmas Day or at any time until 6.00am on 26 December, 100% is added to the above rate of fare.

Fouling Charge £40.00.

- 2.2 This rate of fare produces a daytime rate of £3.80 for the first mile and approximately £2.00 for each subsequent complete mile. 50% is added to the fares at night (11pm to 6am) which produces a current rate of £5.70 for the first mile and approximately £3.00 for each subsequent mile.

3 Increases in Costs

- 3.1 The current underlying inflation rate (RPI percentage change) is 4.5%.
- 3.2 The licensing fees for Hackney Carriages, set by this Council, were last increased by approximately 3% with effect from 1 April 2009.
- 3.3 Consultation with Westminster Insurance (one of the main specialist provider of taxi insurance for many Winchester drivers), revealed that insurance premiums have increased by a minimum of 15% in the last six months, some rising to 25%, depending on circumstances.
- 3.4 The cost of diesel and unleaded fuel has fluctuated between January 2010 and November 2010. In January 2010, prices were 114.1 pence per litre for diesel, and 112.4 pence per litre for petrol. Prices peaked in May 2010 at 123.3 pence per litre for diesel and unleaded 122.1 pence per litre. (Figures are averages for the South East taken from theaa.com). An extra 1p in fuel duty at the start of October 2010 has brought average prices to 121.5 pence per litre for diesel and 118.3 for petrol.
- 3.5 A search on petrolprices.com on 22 November 2010 for the Winchester area shows the average price for diesel was 123.8 pence per litre and unleaded 119.7 pence per litre.
- 3.6 It is impossible to give reliable figures on the costs which drivers incur, given the wide variety of work and hours which drivers do, but the following information may be helpful:-

- a) Fuel – 50,000 miles per year would cost approximately £5,571 (based on 50 mpg for a diesel vehicle), compared to £4,880 in December 2008.
- b) Insurance – varies between £1,100 and £5,000 depending on no claims bonus.
- c) Maintenance – servicing every six weeks – approximately £1,128 (inflation at 4.5%)
- d) Finance - £250 to £500 per month to finance a new vehicle depending on size and type.

4 Consultations with the Taxi trade

- 4.1 In the September 2010 edition of HC PH Bulletin, a newsletter sent by the Licensing Section, drivers were asked to forward their comments regarding a possible fare increase.
- 4.2 One of the private hire operators in Winchester, Wessex Cars wrote in to request a small increase in the pull off charge and a slight reduction in yardage distance.
- 4.3 Mr Michael Collins, one of the hackney carriage and private hire drivers, prepared a document requesting an increase to the pull off charge which was signed by 47 other hackney carriage and private hire drivers. Some drivers have since contacted the Licensing Section to confirm that they signed this document as they do wish to have an increase but are still concerned that it may see a further decline in trade.
- 4.4 Mr John Boardman, a hackney carriage and private hire driver wrote to the Licensing Section requesting no increase in fares due to the current economic situation.
- 4.5 Copies of these representations are included in the Appendices.

5 Comparisons and Possible Options

- 5.1 Appendix 3 shows the National League Tables averages and by area, taken from the November 2010 'Private Hire and Taxi Monthly' showing most of the Hampshire Local Authorities' position in the 'league table'. Winchester is currently 93rd nationally, with Eastleigh, New Forest, East Hampshire and Hart above Winchester in the league table.
- 5.1 The national average one mile fare at tariff one (between 0600 and 2300) is £3.44, the average for the South is £3.77, in Winchester it is currently £3.80.
- 5.2 The national average one mile fare at tariff two (where 50% is added to the fare between 2300 and 0600) is £4.56, the average for the South is £5.26, in Winchester it is currently £5.70.

- 5.3 Appendix 2 sets out 4 possible options for increases. It should be noted that the figures show the actual meter reading at the distances shown for each proposal. The “start fare” is shown on the meter before the taxi moves and changes before the start of the next distance. e.g. for the existing fares, £2.40 is shown on the meter as soon as the vehicle is hired, an additional 20p is shown on the meter after 660 yards and another 20p is added after the next and each subsequent 180 yards. The 4 proposals set out the increase, compared to the existing maximum fares for this Council District, at distances of 1 mile, 3 miles, 5 miles and 10 miles, together with the percentage increase in cost. The proposals compare possible increases which would be shown on the taximeter at the distances shown and the percentage increase is calculated to one decimal point.
- 5.4 In the event of any variation to the existing fares, the statutory provisions require a public notice to be advertised in the local press, and representations invited. Representations can be made by any person, including members of the public and taxi drivers. Any representations made within 14 days must be considered by the Council before the variation is implemented, and it would normally therefore be necessary to bring a further report to Committee to consider these representations.
- 6 Issues for Consideration
- 6.1 **Is it appropriate to increase the maximum fare for hackney carriages?** Members may wish to consider the changes to costs to the taxi trade over the last year and the consequent increase cost to the public.
- 6.2 **If it is considered there should be no increase on this occasion when should the matter next be reviewed?** It may be considered if fares are not increased on this occasion that they should be reviewed in a year's time.
- 6.3 **If it is considered that it is appropriate to increase the fares how is this to be achieved?** Appendix 2 sets out 4 proposals as to how an increase could be achieved. It is felt in the trade that too great a rise at the moment would drive trade away from the taxis towards other form of public transport.
- 6.4 Column 1 of Appendix 3 shows the position of the listed authorities in a league table of fares according to the national taxi trade paper “Private Hire and Taxi Monthly”. Winchester is shown in this table as 93rd out of 380. Copies of the Private Hire and Taxi Monthly will be available for scrutiny at the meeting.
- 6.5 **Should there be any changes to the existing “Waiting Time” Charge?** There have been no requests seeking any change to the waiting time charge. This charge was changed in 2005 from 20 to 25 pence per minute. It may be considered that it is inappropriate, on this occasion, to increase this charge.
- 6.6 **Should there be any changes to the existing “Fouling Charge”?** One of the hackney carriage and private hire drivers has requested that the fouling charge be increased for £40 to £60 to adequately cover the cost of the vehicle being valeted. The Fouling Charge was last increased in 1999 from £35 to

£40. This charge is included in order to support taxi drivers who may have problems in recovering this money and having to go out of service to clean the vehicle. However, drivers do face the difficulty of recovering this charge.

- 6.7 **Should there be any changes to the existing “Extra Charges”?** There have been no requests from the trade this year for any changes and officers do not consider any changes under this heading are required.

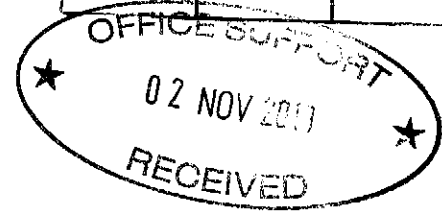

Ref: Proposed Taxi Fare Increases

I would like to state that I am opposed to a fare increase at this time due to the following reasons:

1. Some drivers have been selling their cars to other drivers and replacing with new vehicles. This is increasing the taxi fleet. Some drivers have done this 2 or 3 times.
2. Selling of Taxi plates should not be allowed to other drivers under the guise of selling the business, as plates should be handed back to the Council to be re-distributed.
3. Heathrow Airport is £120 meter price but discounted to £65-£70. Gatwick Airport is £140, discounted to £85-£90. If drivers need a fare increase how can they afford to give such a large discount?
4. Many drivers are refusing certain jobs, or tactfully avoiding some jobs. Surely if there is such a strong need for a fare increase they would not be able to afford to refuse work?
5. If trade is so bad that drivers need a fare increase. Have any hackney plates been handed back to the Council this year?
6. Many vehicles are now up to 8 seaters, which reduces the work available. One 8 seater vehicle is now equivalent to 2 saloon vehicles. Drivers of larger vehicles are charging an extra levy for that vehicle.
7. Now that age restrictions have been re-assessed for taxis, under the Hackney Inspectors discretion, vehicles have an indefinite life span. This is an incentive for drivers to keep their vehicles well maintained and increases the overall profit from the vehicle.
8. If a fare increase is granted the meter change would cost the driver £25.30 plus time, plus travel costs to get the meter re-calibrated, plus the time to get the meter checked by the Hackney inspector.
