In reply to Members' questions, the Head of Licensing explained that it was a licence condition that defined medical conditions should be notified to the licensing authority. The Licensing Authority could refer the driver for a separate medical examination at the driver's expense if it was thought necessary.

Drivers were not separately reminded of the need to report medical conditions, but it was one of the conditions of the annual licence renewal. Where the authority became aware of a driver with a suspected medical condition that had not been self declared it could request a medical examination.
