8	<p><b>Letter dated 08/11/06</b></p> <p>We were keeping in line with all the other venues in Winchester, when Gary Miller wrote to us with his concerns we immediately stopped.</p>
9	<p><b>Letter dated 13/09/07</b></p> <p>We were allowing around 40 people at a time out of the premises to smoke and it was evident too many patrons were blocking the paths and roads. Gary spoke to us and we reduced the numbers to 20 and he was fine with this. Any less would have caused us a major issue with the amount of people who smoke.</p>
11-12	<p><b>Letter dated 16/05/08</b></p> <p>Incident book says she was removed from bar due to being too drunk and ambulance was called. To cure the noise/smoking outside issue we started to use our side communal area as a smoking area, which pleased everyone and we are still using it today and there has been no further issues.</p>
13	<p><b>Letter dated 30/10/2008</b></p> <p>We were led to believe that the capacity was 280 when we purchased the bar back in July 2005. To our knowledge we have had no issues with capacity as regards the police licensing from 2005 to 2008 when this letter was written.</p>
15	<p><b>Letter dated 19/11/2008</b></p> <p>An outside promoter had these flyers printed to promote his night, this was without our consent. When we were alerted to this issue by Gary Miller we immediately had these removed and sacked the promoter.</p>
17	<p><b>Letter dated 24/08/2010</b></p> <p>We have not received this letter to date, however these details have been given to the solicitor acting for Mr [ ].</p>
18	<p><b>Incident dated 13/02/10</b></p> <p>Not logged in our incident book, was this male actually from our premises or just in the square? Cannot comment.</p>
19	<p><b>Incident 25/06/10 – 26/06/10</b></p> <p>Incident book says someone climbed across the roof at the back to sneak into the bar, doorman caught him and ran after him, he struggled and pulled at his ear piece and was removed from premises and arrested. We have to stop people doing this on the roof in view of public safety these roofs are very high.</p>

21	<p><b>Incident dated 06/12/2009</b></p> <p>Incident book states as per this police summary, doorman used reasonable force to protect himself and merely put his hand out to stop him coming further forward. The male was conscious and refused to get up. Witnesses present : Aviv Mana'an, Lee Davies, Calvin Collymore, Tracey Gardner</p>
22	<p><b>Incident 10/09/2010</b></p> <p>Incident book states male in question had started trouble with two other males upstairs, doorman noticed something not right and approached male who told him to f*** off so doorman removed him from premises using reasonable force although male was struggling heavily, when outside doorman returned inside. Need to check if there was a CCTV issue here.</p>
23	<p><b>Incident 22/08/10</b></p> <p>Incident book states events as per police summary other than not mentioned male was outside for an hour being continuously abusive. I have been charged in respect of this incident but have entered a "not guilty" plea. In view of legal advice I do not intend to comment in detail upon this particular incident save to say that I vehemently deny the allegations. This is currently listed for a hearing on 24<sup>th</sup> November 2010.</p>
24	<p><b>Incident 13/08/2010</b></p> <p>Not in incident book, however Lee can recall this incident and it was as per police summary, both left unhappy no problem.</p>
25	<p><b>Incident 08/08/2010</b></p> <p>Not in incident book, group was not from bar, cannot comment.</p>
26	<p><b>Incident 09/07/2010</b></p> <p>In incident book when door staff were leaving to go home, female was outside on pavement. The staff knew her personally and a police officer on foot had also stopped to see her, no taxis would take her so door staff said they would take her home because they knew her, the officer said they would be better taking her to A&amp;E so they dropped her there and left. After a meeting with Gary Miller he mentioned this incident which both myself and Lee were unaware about.</p>
27	<p><b>Incident 04/06/2010</b></p> <p>In incident book events as stated in police summary cannot comment further.</p>

<b>28</b>	<b>Incident 09/04/2010</b>  Not recorded in book, we are not aware of this incident, however at kick out numerous people leave and police are usually outside or up the road a bit and obviously attended this altercation without informing us.
<b>29</b>	<b>Incident 05/03/2010</b>  Not in incident book, no attempts made by police to investigate or request CCTV, who called them?
<b>30</b>	<b>Incident 28/02/10</b>  Not in incident book. This was around kick out time, cannot comment
<b>31</b>	<b>Incident 05/02/2010</b>  In incident book male was refused entry for being drunk, he was outside for around 20 minutes until which time a friend of his dragged him away two doors up. Door staff heard a thud and male had fallen over and knocked himself out in the road, an ambulance was called and he was taken away. A few days later a police officer mentioned in conversation that the male was accusing me (Kalvin) of assaulting him. I feel this was because when he was outside refusing to go I told the door staff to ban him from coming in the bar in future. I did not assault him in any way.
<b>32</b>	<b>Incident 16/12/2009</b>  In incident book male being racially abusive to Freedom [Assistant Manager] outside and threatened to run him over in his car, police called to arrest male. To date we have not been informed of any thing regarding this male from the police.
<b>33</b>	<b>Incident 10/10/2010</b>  Not in book we were not aware of anything here, male may have been seen by CCTV being ejected from bar and walking to other premises prior to being pulled up by police.
<b>34</b>	<b>Incident date 02/10/2009</b>  Incident in book as per police summary male was being severely racially abusive to me (Kalvin) he was arrested charged and convicted. He had a 4 month curfew and 18 month suspended jail sentence given to him for this.
<b>35</b>	<b>Incident 01/10/2010</b>  This incident was at another venue (34 the square WILLIAM WALKER PUB) nothing to do with our bar whatsoever.

<b>37</b>	<b>Incident 22/09/2010</b> Incident in book, all as per police summary cannot comment further.
<b>38</b>	<b>Incident date 08/08/2010</b> Incident in book as per police summary and male was arrested for being drunk.
<b>39</b>	<b>Incident date 06/08/2010</b> Incident in book as per police summary. Group being intimidating to other patrons, so was asked to leave
<b>40</b>	<b>Incident date 30/07/2010</b> Not in incident book. Unknown about this, seems like incident elsewhere in town centre and they walked down the square. Nothing to do with bar.
<b>41</b>	<b>Incident 27/06/2010</b> Not in book, no one called police but they were passing and stopped. No issues as far as we were concerned, male left and went home.
<b>42</b>	<b>Incident 14/07/2010</b> Not in book. Male not been in bar at all he was obviously somewhere else which name has been blanked out. He was followed around Winchester by CCTV and picked up outside our bar whilst trying to get in.
<b>43</b>	<b>Incident date 20/06/2010</b> In book, as per police summary. Female had mental health problems and assaulted door staff because he asked her to leave for being unbalanced in the venue. Her own friends refused to leave with her and said she is a handful, so they left her.
<b>44</b>	<b>Incident date 16/06/2010</b> Not in book, this relates to William Walker again, it seems that CCTV control room staff are using our bar as a location point. This needs to be looked at.
<b>45</b>	<b>Incident date 11/06/2010</b> In incident book as per police summary, we gave CCTV to police for evidence, cannot comment further.

<b>46</b>	<b>Incident date 12/02/2010</b>  Not in book, we cannot comment on it, he obviously never came from the bar and was close to it.
<b>47</b>	<b>Work sheet dated 16/12/2009</b>  This incident as mentioned before, apparently it was members of the public shouting abuse at this male. Gary phoned Lee regarding this and was corrected.
<b>48</b>	<b>Worksheet dated 24/08/2010</b>  On this occasion our door staff informed the police we have had in excess of 340 in throughout the night and not actually holding 340.

<b>49</b>	<b>Worksheet dated 10/09/2010</b>  Incident referred to is in the incident book, however it was not entered until his next shift on the Saturday
<b>50</b>	<b>Last worksheet from Katherine Batt dated 02/10/2010</b>  Yet again CCTV was not operating as it should, we only realised there was another problem when Lee tried to burn off the camera for the date requested. The CCTV was playing but not recording due to its format being changed whilst investigating a previous incident, this was totally unknown at the time.
