REPORT OF THE HEAD OF ENVIRONMENT

DETAIL:

- 1. TPO 1990 Land at St Francis, 9B Ranelagh Road, Winchester
- 1.1 Winchester City Council received a tree works notification to remove this cypress, which lies within the Winchester Conservation Area.
- 1.2 The arboricultural officer attended site to assess the tree and considered that the removal of this tree would be detrimental to the visual amenity of the area and that the tree satisfied the criteria for a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) to be made.
- 1.3 A TPO was made and served on 14 January 2010.
- 1.4 The grounds for making the order were: "A significant tree that contributes to the visual amenity of the area."

Formal Objections

- 1.5 Correspondence has been received from four neighbours objecting to the TPO on the following grounds:
 - this tree is a fast growing species that has already reached a height in excess of 40 feet.
 - it is located close to all of the above properties.
 - should the tree fail in a storm, it would cause significant harm.
 - the cypress is not an attractive tree and so its loss would not be detrimental to the visual amenity of the area.
 - there was no problem when a cypress was removed in 9A.
 - this in a non-native species and so should not be protected.
 - there is an included bark union which increases the risk of failure.
 - the tree is causing damage to the fence of 9B.
 - replacing with a native species would be more sensible.

Officer Comments

1.6 The tree has been assessed using the Tree Evaluation Method for Tree Preservation Orders (TEMPO) and the visual observations of the arboricultural officer. TEMPO is a nationally recognised tool for assessing trees for suitability for TPO and is recommended for use by the Winchester City Council Tree Strategy – consultation draft.

1.7 tree scored highly given its visual amenity value and prominence in landscape.

- 1.8 In response to the objection, the arboricultural officer's report stated that:
 - The tree is located to the rear of St Francis, 9B Ranelagh Road. Given its current size the tree can be seen from a number of surrounding residential properties and the main road.
 - The concerns that the objectors have raised are not considered to be sound arboricultural reasons.
 - At the time of inspection, the tree was found to be in reasonable overall condition and there was certainly no reason to suggest that the tree was at all dangerous.
- 1.9 The tree officer would be happy to meet with an applicant onsite to discuss appropriate work to the trees and to provide guidance on submitting a formal application.


