<u>Update</u>

This application has been reported to committee due to Winchester City Council

being the applicant (New Homes Team).

An additional letter of representation has been received, which whilst generally supporting of the proposal, echoes the concerns of the parish council in respect of allocation of parking spaces. Concern was also expressed about the quality of the internal layouts, and access to the rear of the properties.

The following Landscape Response has now been received:

With reference to the pre application landscape response dated 22.03.2011 and proposed site layout, drawing no 103-B.

Recommendation:

No objections. Advise inclusion of a landscape condition if minded to grant consent.

Observations:

The site lies within residential development at the end of a cul de sac. It lies on the northern edge of the SDNP in an elevated location with glimpses of far reaching views to the east and south of site. The disused railway embankment along the northern boundary supports vegetation of diverse age and condition which as a group provides amenity value both locally and in the wider landscape. There are variable levels within the site; main design constraints will include treatment of levels and potential impact on boundary trees.

Proposals:

In general, I am very supportive of the amended proposals. The proposed layout addresses main site constraints and previous landscape concerns relating to potential impacts on the wider landscape, including SDNP, previously raised at pre-application stage.

Minor concerns remain regarding feasibility of landscape boundary treatment to parking area although I believe these are details that may be resolved as a condition if minded to grant consent.

Regarding soft landscape, detailed planting proposals need to ensure that they are compatible with both ecology and landscape amenity requirements.'
