

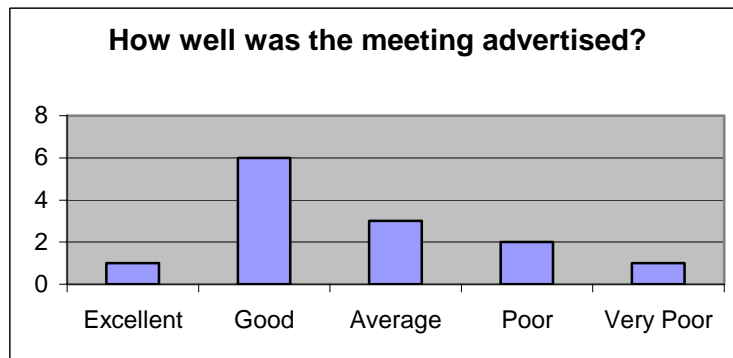

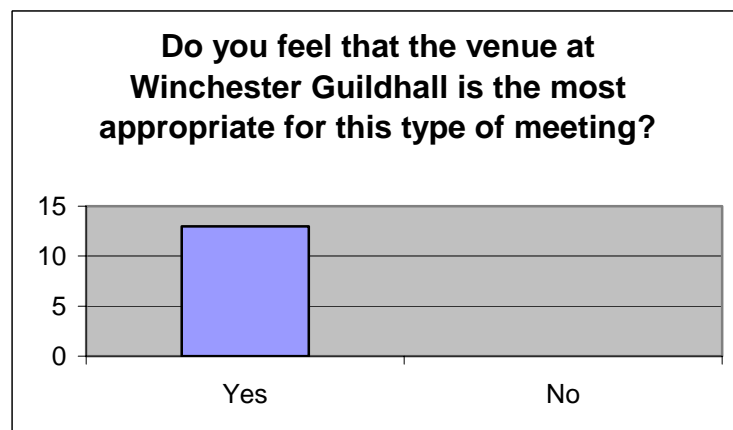
Evening Economy Meeting 11 May 2005

Results of the 13 completed questionnaires from the approximately 40 in attendance at the Winchester Town Forum meeting. The comments are direct quotes from the questionnaires.



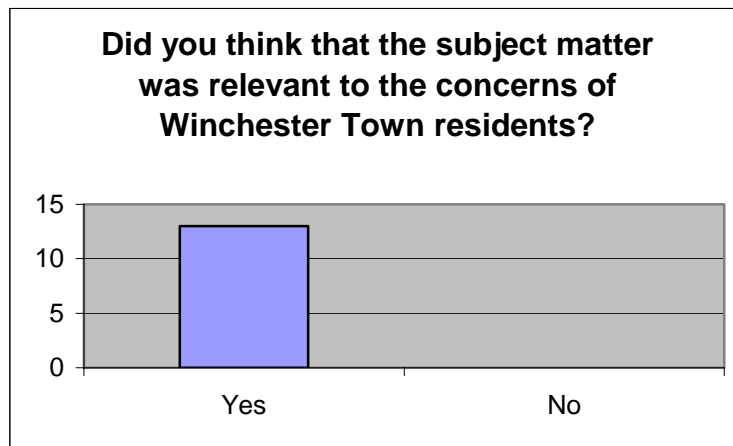
Comments:

- No reference on the website – at least I couldn't find it!



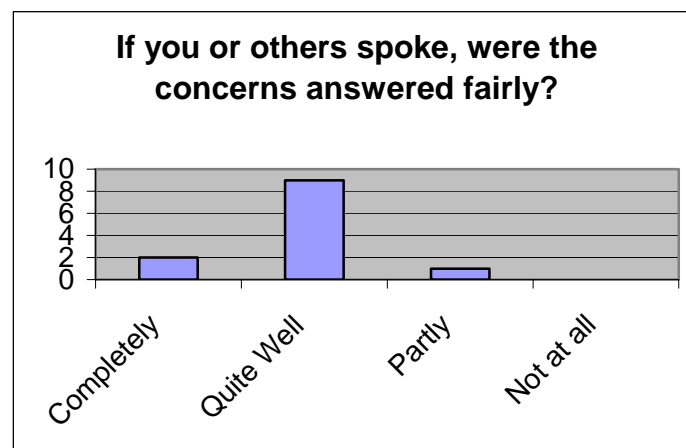

- Smaller room would have been better



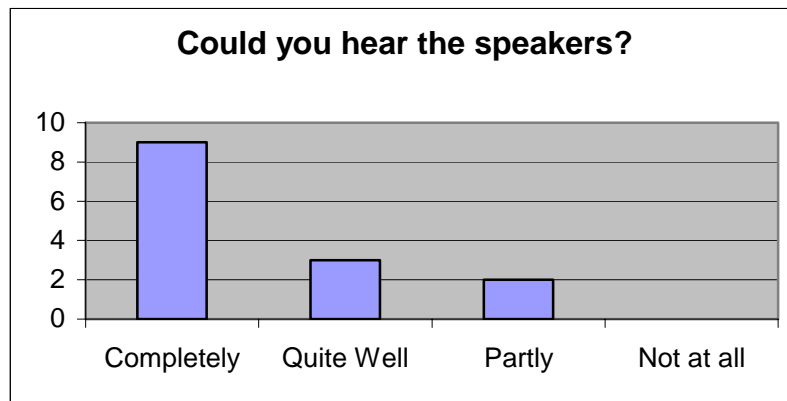
Comments and other subjects the Forum should discuss at future meetings:

- Night-time violence

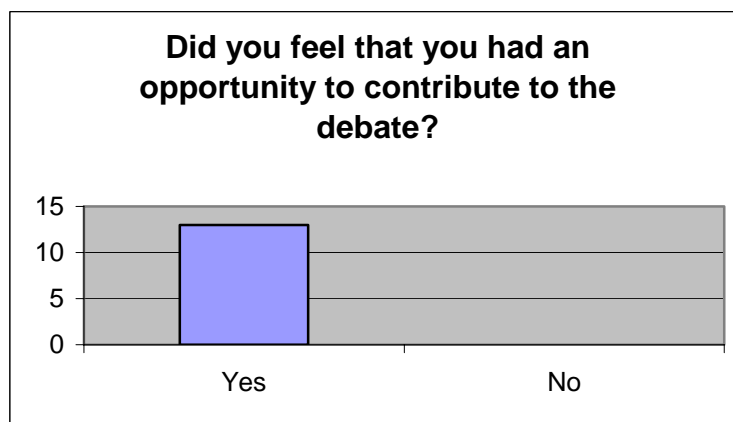
