#### Description

Grade I 12th and 13th century quadrangle buildings erected by Henry de Blois, enlarged in the 15<sup>th</sup> century, restored by Butterfield in 1864-5. The List description describes the chapel and Hospital buildings as being "one of the most beautiful groups of buildings in the country".

### Nature of works

Stonework repairs to seven chimneys and sundial, and leadwork repairs to roof abutments

### **Previous Grant History**

Part of an ongoing programme of repairs to repair Hospital buildings and Chapel.

### **Estimated Costs**

#### Report

This is continuing programme of external repairs to this Grade I listed building. The condition survey has shown that several of the stacks are structurally unsafe and will need taking down and rebuilding, replacing badly eroded stone with matching stone. Elsewhere, indenting to stonework will be required and leadwork will be renewed next to chimneys. The works specification demands an appropriately high standard of repair and this will be supervised by the conservation architect appointed by St. Cross Hospital.

The building is at a strategic location within Winchester Conservation Area and clearly a significant historic asset. An application has been made to Hampshire County Council and it is recommended that the Council make a grant offer at 20%.

# RECOMMENDED

That a grant of up to £8,111 (20% of eligible works) be offered.
