1. Introduction

- 1.1 This report presents to Members an update on the progress that the Council is making with the projects and programmes that form the Corporate Business Plan 2009-2014.

Detailed feasibility not undertaken in agreement with Portfolio holder as initial screening process confirmed costs in the region of $\pounds 200,000$ or more which could not be met from within existing resources requiring a growth bid which was unlikely to succeed. It is also considered that implementation costs in relation to the likely level of increase in recycling (1-2%) would not be cost effective.

However, work is currently underway to re-let the current depot contract in partnership with East Hampshire District Council and proposed specification likely to include such future developments for recycling services provided these are deemed feasible and affordable.
