Observations:

- 1. Decisions made in light of the fact that there will be reduced funding over the next couple of years
- 2. There is a need to identify essential services and those which provide a high benefit amongst the organisations that we fund
- 3. Consideration could be given to split payments and against set conditions in grant, 2nd payment after SLA/conditions signed off for payments over £5,000. However, this was discussed with the Alexis Garlick during the previous grant cycle and agreement was reached to split payments only for organisations over £50,000 due to the cash flow of the organisations and the Officer time involved with processing this.
- 4. Organisations need to explore partnership working and the sharing of resources. Partnership working needs to be a condition of the grant (this is already written into some SLAs for 2012/2013)
- 5. Winnall, Stanmore, Highcliffe area substantially funded via the core grants programme however: they are district priorities with general areas of deprivation which require support as they are in the bottom 25% of the country
