The Head of Development Management referred Members to the Update Sheet which made reference to additional sections on pages 3 and 6 of the Report setting out the comments of the Rights of Way Officer. Additional conditions were also included as follows: Condition 15 relating to the submission of a traffic management system; condition 16 relating to a walk over condition survey of the local highway network and the access to the site, and condition 17 relating to the submission of a plan indicating the positions, design, materials and type of boundary treatment to be erected. Further, additional informatives were also included on page 11 of the report relating to Hampshire County Council in its role as Highway Authority.
