To note the making of Emergency Tree Preservation Orders to protect trees of amenity value.

PLANNING DEVELOPMENT CONTROL COMMITTEE22 May 2003EMERGENCY TREE PRESERVATION ORDERSREPORT OF DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT SERVICESDETAIL:

- 1 TPO 1785. Sleepers Acre, Sparkford Rd, Winchester.
  - 1.1 An emergency TPO was made and served on 3 April 2003 to protect a large Walnut and a Deodar Cedar tree from development pressure. The trees are of high amenity value adding to the character of the area.
- 2 TPO 1786. The Yard, Trampers Lane, North Boarhunt.
  - 2.1 An emergency TPO was made and served on 1 April 2003 to protect a very large Ash tree from possible harm. The tree is of significant amenity value and is an integral part of the streetscene.
- 3 TPO 1787. Hazemount, Park Road, Winchester.
  - 3.1 An emergency TPO was made and served on 9 April 2003 to protect an important Sycamore from possible harm. This roadside tree contributes significantly to the character of the area.
- 4 TPO 1788. 6 Elizabeth Road, Wickham.
  - 4.1 An emergency TPO was made and served on 17 April 2003 to protect an Oak tree from developmental pressure. This important Oak is of considerable amenity importance adding greatly to the character of the area.
- 5 TPO 1789. Dunrovin, Upper Crabbick Lane, Denmead.
  - 5.1 An emergency TPO was made and served on 24 April 2003 to protect a large roadside Oak from possible harm. This Oak is very prominent and is an integral component of the character of the area.
- 6 TPO 1790. 151-155 Springvale Road, Kings Worthy.
  - 6.1 An emergency TPO was made and served on 23 April 2003 to protect seven trees from development proposals. The trees are of high amenity value adding to the character of the area.
