- One of the first Council built Passivhaus plus schemes in the country
- §4 x 1 bed flats and 2 x 2 bed flats
- Projected energy savings 75% lower running costs than a property built to current building regulations
- than a property built to contain the highest standard of thermal efficiency
 - ₹78% less carbon generated
 - Completion scheduled December 2023


