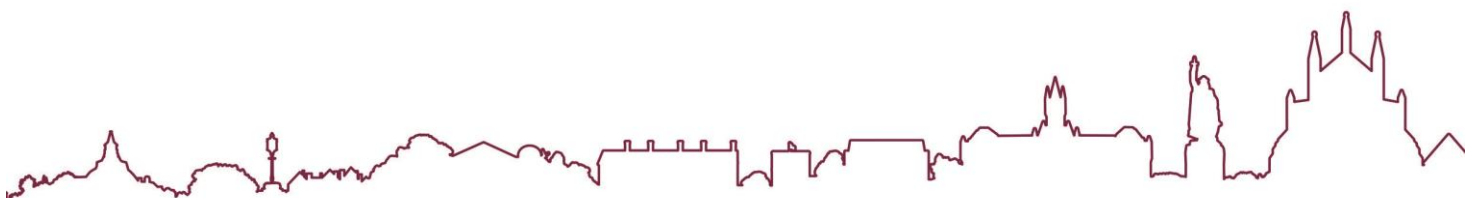

## Regulations for behaviour and facility use
