





WINCHESTER DEVELOPMENT PLAN




STAGES IN PREPARING A SOUND LOCAL PLAN

UPDATE ON THE PARTNERSHIP FOR SOUTH HAMPSHIRE (PFSH WORK)

- FfSH to produce a 'Statement of Common Ground'
 to assess development needs and distribution
- Consultants are due to be appointed to undertake the following work:
 - Assessment of Strategic Development Opportunity Areas (SDOAs) including transportation modelling, landscape, ecology, GI, health, infrastructure and mix of use
 - Economic and Commercial Needs Assessment
 - Habitats Regulations Assessment (HRA) and Sustainability Assessment
 - Strategic Flood Risk Assessment

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UPDATE ON THE PARTNERSHIP FOR SOUTH HAMPSHIRE (PFSH WORK)

- The work will assess a number of SDOA's (areas of at least 20 hectares or capable of accommodating at least 500 dwellings)
- Fair Oak SDOA's (not to be assessed) including within/adjoining WCC West of Waterlooville, North ☆ Whiteley, Welborne and Land North of Bishopstoke /Fair Oak
- SHELAA work and previous studies
 SHELAA work and previous studies

UPDATE ON THE PARTNERSHIP FOR SOUTH HAMPSHIRE (PFSH WORK)

- The work will assess other 'unconstrained' land which does not have designations
- Working with the PfSH Planning Officers group and reporting to Members
- 🖗 NPPF requires WCC to work with neighbouring ਰੋ LPAs under the DTC and to produce Statements of Common Ground
- Better to be part of the process, which will be evidence based
