TOPIC - TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER - CHERITON ROAD, WINCHESTER

SUMMARY

- Inconsiderate motorists are causing potential road safety hazards outside the
 Westgate School Cheriton Road, Winchester by parking adjacent to the school
 entrance and by waiting on the double yellow lines at the nearby junctions. The
 school has tried to mitigate these problems by placing no waiting cones, but this
 is not a sustainable solution.
- Following meetings with the school, local councillors and HCC officers it was
 agreed to introduce enforceable school keep clear (zig-zag) restrictions adjacent
 to the school entrance as well as to introduce 'no loading' restrictions to the
 existing double yellow lines at the junctions to prevent motorists from waiting at
 these locations and thereby help keep these areas clear for cars to safely pass.

- The proposed changes were advertised on 13 February 2019. Notices were
 posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in
 the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in
 the City Office reception. No responses were received in relation to the proposal.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council and/or the budget provided by Winchester City Council. There will be no additional enforcement costs.
- Copy of the plan showing the location and extent of the proposal is attached (Appendix 1).
- Copy of proposed schedule and statement of reasons is attached (Appendix 2).

PROPOSED DECISION

- 1. That restrictions be introduced as detailed in the schedule attached (Appendix 2).
- 2. That the Head of Legal Services [Interim] be authorised to make the necessary order.
