| Gosport | No position statement Only issuing consent where nutrient neutrality can be demonstrated. Refusing applications where this cannot be demonstrated. |
| Havant | Nutrient neutral position statement is being applied – July 2019 |
| Winchester | Applications on hold pending agreement to adopt Position Statement Issue did not emerge until September 2019 and initially only applied to major development and to the southern part of the district. October 2019 applied to all development across the District. |
| Portsmouth | Nitrate mitigation strategy – November 2019 |
| Southampton | No position statement |
| Test Valley | No position statement Only issuing consent where nutrient neutrality can be demonstrated. Refusing applications where this cannot be demonstrated. |
| New Forest | Position statement on nutrient neutral development – 4 th September 2019 |
