**The Petition on organising concurrent consultations
with the residents of eight blocks of flats
of 69-163 Firmstone Road in Winnall**

On 8th December 2023 the 'Firmstone Project Proposal' (see attach 1) has been formally submitted to the Estate Improvements and the Planning offices of the Winchester City Council for reconciliation. The said proposal is aiming to create the 'Community Green Space at Winnall' community garden on an old allotment that is located between the garages behind the blocks of flats of 81-103 Firmstone Road, SO23 0PB. The said proposal has been supported by Winnall residents (including those who live in these blocks of flats) who have signed the letter in its support (see attach 2).

In the last week of February 2024 the Council has changed the bins storage arrangements for 48 households of eight blocks of flats of 69-163 Firmstone Road in Winnall. That change has resulted in significant reduction in quality of life for those residents as some of them have to walk 350 yards to dispose their rubbish. For comparison, the previous bins arrangements were just a few steps from the ground floor door.

We are Winnall residents and are supporting this petition and requiring the Council:

1. to organise concurrent consultations with the residents of eight blocks of flats of 69-163 Firmstone Road in Winnall in regards of the bins storage arrangements and the 'Community Green Space at Winnall' community garden;
2. to reconcile the 'Firmstone Project Proposal of 8 December 2023'.




































