## **REGISTER OF MEMBERS' INTERESTS - NOTES FOR GUIDANCE**

Within 28 days of becoming a member or your re-election or re-appointment to office you must register with the Monitoring Officer of the principal authority (Winchester City Council) the interests which fall within the categories of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests which are as described in "The Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012". You should also register details of your other personal interests which fall within the categories set out as Other Registerable Interests.

The register of interests will, in accordance with the requirements of the Localism Act 2011, be available for public inspection including via the website of Winchester City Council

NOTE - "Disclosable Pecuniary Interest" means an interest of yourself, or of your partner if you are aware of your partner's interest, within the descriptions set out.

"Partner" means a spouse or civil partner, or a person with whom you are living as husband or wife, or a person with whom you are living as if you are civil partners.

2. If you are in doubt about the completion of this form, please seek further guidance
3. Do NOT include any abbreviations or acronyms
4. Remember that Disclosable Pecuniary Interests include those of your spouse/partner.
5. Ensure that you enter "None" in any of the boxes under headings where there is nothing to be registered
6. Remember to keep your Register of Interests up to date. Complete a new form when your interests change. You must ensure that your register of interests is kept up-to-date and within 28 days of becoming aware of any new interest, or of any change to a registered interest
7. Be aware that it is an offence to fail to register interests in accordance with the Localism Act 2011 and The Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012.

### **Sensitive Interests**

There are circumstances set out within the 'sensitive information' provisions of Section 32 of the Localism Act where you do not need to put an interest on the public register or declare the nature of an interest at a meeting, although you would have to declare in general terms that you have an interest.

An interest will be a sensitive interest if the two following conditions apply: (a) That you have an interest (whether or not a DPI); and (b) the nature of the interest is such that you and the monitoring officer consider that disclosure of the details of the interest could lead to you or a person connected to you being subject to violence or intimidation.

You must notify the Monitoring Officer of the information you believe is sensitive, along with your reasons and any supporting evidence. If the Monitoring Officer agrees, the information does not need to be included in the public register and will be redacted from the published version and replaced with the following: "Sensitive information held under Section 32 of the Localism Act". If the Monitoring Officer disagrees, then the interest must be registered.

If you believe that you have a sensitive interest, then please indicate this on the form and provide any necessary supporting information.

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
